A SHORT INTRODUCTION.

ARCHITECTEN DE VYLDER VINCK TAILLIEU

In 2009 was made permanent what had already been foreseen. *architecten de vylder vinck taillieu* – a dvvt – is the new name under which Jan De Vylder, Inge Vinck and Jo Taillieu will further share their mutual appreciation, interest and previous realized work. Already long before each one of them, sometimes in collaboration with each other, steadily developed and realized a certain variety of projects. Since 2009 it is clear that *a dvvt* has given wings to the united view on what architecture can possibly stand for.

architecten de vylder vinck taillieu wants to be complete. To embrace not only design but also the making; that is the point of departure for a dvvt. Only through understanding how something is created, design is able to play out its critical attitude. Within the landscape of present-day expectations, a dvvt unexpectedly wants to give these expectations an appropriate turn through which not only what is expected is granted, but surprisingly more can be found. A critical attitude; not as just a gesture but as a living instrument to arrive further than ever expected.

The social responsibility that is based within architecture should not be underestimated. But only if the architect audits this responsibility critically, this social task has the possibility to surpass a mere filling-in of expectations and obtains the chance to its cultural dimension. Here, the architect has a crucial responsibility. *a dvvt wants to recognize this*. The skill of the architect – the craft; the knowledge and the critical attitude – is crucial with this. This skill ensures that present-day expectations like cultural sustainability have the possibility to stand for more than what they stand for today. The *métier* as the key to the future.

JAN DE VYLDER INGE VINCK JO TAILLIEU

Jan De Vylder (1968), Inge Vinck (1973) and Jo Taillieu (1971) all three are principle architects and business partners. But first and foremost architects. This was the point of departure for a dvvt. The actual effort for design and for realization stays paramount.

To keep doing this for every project and to keep further defining the appropriate effort together with the client in the course the entire process is of primary importance.

PRACTICE

Although the above is written first the practice is just as much strength of architecten de vylder vinck *taillieu*. Next to Jan De Vylder, Inge Vinck and Jo Taillieu, stands a strong and diverse team of sixteen collaborators. Collaborators who already from the start draw along with the first lines that were set out; and young collaborators – much internship are part of this - who help giving further sharpness and speed to the élan *a dvvt* enjoys today.

GHENT BRUSSELS

The practice has been founded and is since then based in Ghent. Since 2017 a depending office have been opened in Brussels.

COLLABORATING PRACTICES

Collaborating practices is key to the world of architecture today. Collaborations with offices like HDSPV architecten (Ghent); KGDVS architects (Brussels) and AgwA (Brussels) are part. But also international collaborations are part. More then once teams have been found with BRUTHER (FR); BRANDLHUBER+ (DE) and DRDH ARCHITECTS (GB).

PROJECTS AND CLIENTS

The projects of *architecten de vylder vinck taillieu* range from the smallest commission possible as well as large sized commissions: projects for an individual client as well as a public client or private investor. Projects with very diverse character: ranging from simply a house to a university campus; a cultural client as well as a public commission. The projects are obtained through competitions, selections or direct commission. *a dvvt* realize projects both in Belgium and in foreign countries.

cultural

The project **LES BALLETS C DE LA B & LOD** was a breakthrough in scale; it allows *architecten de vylder vinck taillieu* to test its view on architecture on a larger scale and on the complexity of the historic city.

This also opened the perspective towards a range of **CULTURAL PROJECTS**.

For the Municipal Museum of Contemporary Art S.M.A.K. in Ghent *a dvvt* designed an extension for the collection **MARCEL BROODTHAERS**. In 2008 theatre company **HET TONEELHUIS** asks to provide accommodation for their offices situated in the adjoining buildings of the well-known historic BOURLA theatre in the heart of the city of Antwerp. **SOLOMON R GUGGENHEIM** is since 2011 on the client list of *architecten de vylder vinck taillieu*.

More recently a permanent PAVILION and PODIUM for the MUSIC FESTIVAL HORTS have been realized.

Today with the team AdvvtgwA-6A – a joined team between 6A ARCHITECTS (UK) and a dvvt and AgwA (Brussels) - work is made of the competition for a new **BRUSSELS MUSEUM** for **CONTEMPORARY ARTS** and **CULTURAL CENTRE** at the former site and in the former building known as the CITROEN GARAGE in BRUSSELS and in close collaboration with the **CENTRE POMPODOU**. A project values 125.000.000,-€ and initiated by BRUSSELS GEWEST and organized by its **URBAN DEVELOPMENT COMPANY** SAU-MSI.

public

For the **URBAN DEVELOPMENT COMPANIES** AG SOB and VESPA, respectively for the cities of **GHENT** and **ANTWERP**, *a dvvt* draws various projects. The projects are about HOUSES and HOUSING. For the city of Ghent a dvvt realized several houses for the special project called **KAVEL** and which is about regenerating privately build houses organized by public initiative finally hand over to private families..

In 2016 the new **CULTURAL CENTRE AND ADMINSTRATIVE POOL** in the former city hall of district Ledeberg of the city of Ghent has been delivered. It combines office for the administration of the city with police offices and with a small theater place and more public spaces for social and cultural use.

For the provincial government of EAST FLANDERS a proposal for their new **HEADQUARTERS** in the former old kazerne at the citadel of Ghent delivered first prize. The project was valued **75.000.000,-€**. Change of political climate canceled the project. This change also leaded to the cancelation of the project for a new districts house in Borgerhout part of Antwerp. When the GHENT UNIVERSITY unites with HOGESCHOOL GHENT the proposal for the extension of the HENLEY campus with a new **LIBRARY** and new **AUDITORIUM** was put on hold. This project was valued in first phase **15.000.000,-€**

The city of CHARLEROI licensed their urban development company IGRETEC the renovation and restorations of the **60.000m2 PALAIS DES EXPO**. This competition has been won in 2016 and yet now the demand on building permit has been asked and the documents for the tendering are to be finalized. This project is the result of a collaboration wit AgwA.

All those projects were result of competitions.

public private partnership

Today private investment and development are going hand in hand. The projects **VOS EN BOS** (Ghent) and **CADIX (Antwerp)** – both on housing - are although the initial public demand finally realized by private involvement. PPP is the principle key.

The **SERVICE CENTER** and **SERVICE FLATS** in the **IGLO** project on the left bank of Antwerp have been commissioned by the **SOCIAL HOUSING** company OCMW but delivered by private investment.

private

PRIVATE INVESTMENT AND DEVELOPMENT COMPANIES found their way to a dvvt. The project for **RESIDENTIAL HOUSING** – 52 apartments – in the context of the old **WIVINA ABBEY** is the first in a range of other projects dealing with **CARE** on that site. It has been delivered 2016 and it was estimated **17.500.000,-€** although realized 15.500.000,-€. Elderly housing and services are on the drawing table. The reconversion of the former abbey in a **WORKSPACE** was delivered yet 2014. This project is example for **MIXED USE** programming.

For the same investor new projects are delivered or at the drawing table. **KAPPELLEVELD** dealing with service flats and elderly housing will be delivered by the end of the year 2017. The projects **NEEROM** and **BODEGEM** are moving on to the demand for building permit.

In the **NETHERLANDS** a housing project situated in the historical center of AMERSFOORT have been delivered.

care

This project **IGLO** – which is the abbreviation for mixed generation project for the left bank of Antwerp – was result of a competition. The initial question was a MASTERPLAN for this left bank side. At the same time the realization of a large volume of housing with divers program from living with service to elderly housing. Including local service center and other public accommodation. Once again a **MIXED PROGRAM** project. On top the re-organization and realization of the **PUBLIC SPACE**.

In the frame of the special open call of the Flemish Bouwmeester with the theme **FUTURE CARE LIVING** the project called **ZORG DORP** was awarded.

For the city of AARSCHOT a new **SERVICE CENTRE** and **SERVICE FLATS** have been delivered 2017. This project has been realized in collaboration with DRDH ARCHITECTS (UK)

For the **PSYCHIATRIC CLINIC PC CARITAS** a special project have been realized. A not anymore valid building have been saved from demolishing by redefined it as a new kind of public space at the same time new spaces for ways of treatment and working in way as never before. An unexpected outcome of a competition.

The project for a new **VETRINARY CLINIC** MALPERTUUS has been delivered 2009.

special

For the village of GOOIK a new **NATURE VISITING CENTRE** will go on tendering soon. And for the **SCOUTS** of TERNAT new accommodation is on the drawing table. For a cultural center **WARP** in SINT-NIKLAAS a first sketch has been delivered.

A private ART COLLECTOR demanded to renovate an old warehouse in to a **DEPOT FOR ART**. An ART COLLECTIVE demanded a masterplan and a design for the renovation of the heritage of a painter into an **ART CENTER**.

A simple **bus stop** is build in a project called **BUS:STOP** at Unter Krumbach (AU) amongst others like Suo Fugimoto, Alexander Brodsky, Smiljan Radic, Wang Shu, Rintalla Eggerson, Anton Garcia Abril.

In the old city of MATERA in ITALY the winery **ENOTECA DAI TOSI** have been delivered spring 2017. A competition won end of 2015. Furniture was part.

In 2008 **Herzog & deMeuron** invites *architecten de vylder vinck taillieu* for their project ORDOS 100, initiated by **H&dM** and directed by **Ai WEIWEI**.

architecten de vylder vinck taillieu was shortlisted by the **NOBLE PRIZE COMMITY** amongst 20 practices for their invited competition - 170 practices - for the new to be built **NOBLE PRIZE CENTER** in Stockholm Sweden. *architecten de vylder vinck taillieu* lined up with OFFICE Kersten Geers David Van Severen.

retail

It all started with the gallery VERZAMELD WERK - a gallery for design and things beyond -.

It got follow up with the TWIGGY shop. The shop for the Belgian designer Nathalie Vleeschouwers was next. And the cross-over shop TANGRAM one of the last. If not LA FILLE D'O for the designer Murielle Scheire is the most recent.

competitions

For the Flemish Broadcasting Company VRT and in the frame of an open call of the Flemish Bouwmeester a proposal for their new **HEADQUARTERS** have been presented in 2016. The project was values 110.000.000,-€.

For the city of PARIS two competitions for on housing in **TOWERS** and combined mixed program have been delivered. Special mentioning was part. This project was in collaboration with BRUTHER (FR). Spring 2017 a proposal for social housing at SAINT-DENYS (FR) have been delivered. A project in collaboration with PATRICE MOTTINI (FR).

For the city of LILLE a proposal for the reconversion of an **OLD CITY BLOCK** as also a proposal for a **SCHOOL** was presented. Again a collaboration with BRUTHER (FR).

Proposals have been handed in the frame of the campaign **SCHOLEN VAN MORGEN**.

For the **ART SCHOOL** of HAMBURG proposal for the extensions have been developed with BRANDLHUBER+ (DE)

For the new **MUSEUM FOR CONTEMPORY ART KANAL** in Brussels a proposal titled **CIT** together with 6A ARCHITECTS, AgwA, Muck Petzet and Matthieu Welner has been proposed early 2018.

For the new **MARITIME MUSEUM of ANTWERP** a proposal in collaboration with 6A ARCHITECTS has been presented early 2018.

Being invited in a competition for **LABORATORIES AND OFFICES** for the multi-national **CARGILL** a proposal has been presented in April.

Soon a proposal for a **WATCHTOWER** at the Belgian coast will be hand over.

house

One makes in an other way other projects then houses differently if one makes houses still. A vast and continuous list and ongoing commissions stay important to *architecten de vylder vinck taillieu*.

The first projects 43, house H and house BS brought *a dvvt* in the perspective of the architectural discourse. Today, houses like BM, BERNHEIM BEUK, PEPINGHEN, VERBRANDE BRUG, FRIANT, DWORP and STEEN HOUW VEST confirm this ongoing interest. The houses deal with as well refurbishment as with restoration; as well with new build; from city houses to villa houses

The participation in the series of KAVEL houses of the city of Ghent opens the discourse on nowadays living in cities.

On top the houses ROT-ELLEN-BERG, ENGHIEN and SPADE ZAAM deal with the DIY challenge.

OBJECTS AND FURNITURE

jij's

Known as **JIJ'S** – the first name's first letter of each of one completed by the collaboration with Serge Vandenhove makes the name of the brand – *a dvvt* developed a variety of objects and furniture; from ready for use to thinking exercise.

The series **ODE** has been founded – a series in which reflections on existing examples of furniture is commented -. The first series ODE MVS and ODE EAM are a tribute to MAARTEN VAN SEVEREN and RAY & CHARLES EAMES.

With this *architecten de vylder vinck taillieu* emphasize that whatever it may be: from small to big, from table to campus, from family to public client; from cultural commission to investment assignment; in each

case *a dvvt* does not want anything to escape their attention: in each case wants to draw, with the same enthusiasm and perseverance, a surprising result.

In spring 2013 at the **MILAN DESIGN FAIR** a new collection was put on show. Collection based on the work of the Belgian designer and artist Pieter De Bruyne.

Spring 2016 new work have been presented on the invitation of the galleria **MANIERA** in Brussels. The series **KAMER** RENEE, KAMER FILLE and KAMER PAOLO have been founded. And the series ODE have been continued with the **ODE** TIXIT.

For the BRENDA GALLERY in NEW YORK new work in the SERIES of KAMERS will be presented.

MONOGRAPHS

As a result of LA BIENNALE DI VENEZIA 12.MOSTRA INTERNAZIONALE DE ARCHITETTURA 2010 (IT) the first part of a three book monograph is published. The following two parts are eventually published together with that first part a year later because of the **first retrospective ARCHITECTEN DE VYLDER VINCK TAILLIEU** in DESINGEL INTERNATIONAL ART CAMPUS ANTWERP (BE) 2011.

1 boek 1 – architecten de vylder vinck taillieu ISBN 978-94-906930-8-4 1 boek 2 – architecten de vylder vinck taillieu ISBN 978-94-906931-2-1 1 boek 3 – architecten de vylder vinck taillieu ISBN 978-94-906931-3-8

1 boek 1 and 1 boek 3 bring together drawings and projects in an unexpected order, surprising rather than just showing. 1 boek 2 arranges the stories of the projects with a variety of approaches of the work by architecture critics such as Paul Vermeulen; Kersten Geers; Katrien Vandermarliere en Joachim Declerck, together with fragments of appreciation of Christophe van Gerrewey; Ai Weiwei; Stefan Devoldere; Adam Caruso, Shane O'toole. *a dvvt* arranges the work again in a different way in the text *"So much. But what? About. About this and about that. And then so. And then this"*. This bookset is realized in collaboration with **deSingel** and **MER PAPER KUNSTHALLE**.

September 2013 **2G N.66** *architecten de vylder vinck taillieu* by GG editore has been released. Texts from Tony Fretton, Christophe Van Gerrewey, Moritz Küng and Sam Chermayeff & Johanna Mayer Grohbrügge

May 2016 the monograph in the series **DE AEDIBUS** international n°13 architecten de vylder vinck taillieu by QUART VERLAG has been released. Introduction text by Maarten Delbeke. In 2018 this monograph went into second print.

2017

May 2017 the monograph **A+U 561 17:06** *architecten de vylder vinck taillieu* has been released. Text by Lieven De Cauter, Gideon Boie, Angela Pang and Seng Kuan. *a dvvt* concluded with the text *architecture is not a matter of architecture.*

All the 3 monographs are al together part of a kind of reflections moment. Was **1** boek **1 2 3** a way of ordering and re-ordering the way *a dvvt* made and reflected; the 3 monographs added another way of reflecting by redrawing and rewriting. Combining plans, elevation and sections into on drawing on one hand. Catching the fundamental idea or ideas in an axonometric drawing on the other hand.

jan de vylder inge vinck io taillieu

On the occasions of those 3 monographs a new bookset 3 book 7 8 9 – 2GN66Dai131+U561 - architecten de vylder vinck taillieu will be released end 2017. 3 book 7 8 9 is once again a publication collaboration with MER PAPER KUNSTHALLE. And a limited edition.

As a box set, 3 boek 7 8 9 follows the already published 1 boek 1 2 3 and the not yet published 2 boek 4 5 6. In contrast to the first set of books – fully edited by the office itself and conceived as a continuous, associative, cross-referencing text – this third set takes an opposite approach. The box compiles the three existing monographs – a re-enactment of the out-of-print 2G N. 66, the 13th catalogue from the series De aedibus international and the recently published a+u 561 17:06 – and brings these 'as-found objects' together in one narrative.

The editorial strategy employed in connecting the three separate monographs is an extension of the office's overall attitude towards architecture, as demonstrated in their work. Using formal interventions of copying and cutting, the monographs – each with their own household identity – are appropriated and related to each other. As such, the box set not only presents an overview of projects, it embodies these projects in the texture of the publication itself. 3 boek 7 8 9 is available in a limited edition of 97 issues and is accompanied by a short essay on architects' books by Moritz Küng.

On the occasion of being invited by the Flemish Community in the Belgian Pavilion at the Venice Biennial 2016 REPORT FROM THE FRONTIER as curator of the Belgian Pavilion – in the curatorial team called BRAVOURE – the catalog **BRAVOURE SCARCITY BEAUTY** has been edited in close collaboration with the **VAi** - Flemish Architecture Institute.

DIVISARI BOOKS has released just released – October 2017 - two boxed booksets of each 5 books on *architecten de vylder vinck taillieu*. Those two boxes are part of a set of three boxes. One is on houses; on on large scale building and one on other programs. The first and last is yet released. The one on the larger scaled buildings soon. The pictures of **FILIP DUJARDIN** are leading in the presentation. In 2018 the third volume has been released. And two more to come.

INDEXNEWPAPER has released – July 2017 - a small monograph on *architecten de vylder vinck taillieu* focusing on the large range of houses and having a text of Bart Decroos..

2018

On the occasion of having been invited by the curators YVONNE FARRELL AND SHELLEY MCNAMARA for her exhibition FREESPACE at the BIENNALE DI VENEZIA 16.MOSTRA INTERNAZIONALE DE ARCHITETTURA 2018 the project CARITAS has been presented and the release of a catalogue titled **UNLESS EVER PEOPLE** went along with that.

Following that book set **2 book 4 5 6 - architecten de vylder vinck taillieu** is in its final editing and is expected to be released second half of 2018. This book set will contain the BRAVOURE SCARCITY BEAUTY catalog as also the UNLESS EVER PEOPLE catalogue an finally also the long waited catalogue on the CAROUSSEL show at ETH.

And at this point work is made of **4** boek **10 11 12** architecten de vylder vinck taillieu and will be a bookset that picks up the tradition of **1** boek **2 3 4**.

By end of June 2008 the Spanish monograph series ARCHIVES will release a new monograph **ARCHIVES 3** architecten de vylder vinck taillieu

And new monographs are released for 2018/2019.

www and instagram

The website **www.architectendvvt.com** was the first entrance to digital platforms. As it is a very generous en extensive look into the world of *a dvvt* it has lovers and haters but nothing in between.

In contrast to that the recently released INSTAGRAM delivers an almost daily and immediate inside view.

PUBLICATIONS

The work of *a dvvt* is published internationally. **ARCH+** (GE); **A+U** (JP); C3 (KO); **Bauwelt** (DE).; **Werk, Bauen + Wohnen** (CH) and **ORIS** (SL). The **ARCHITECTURAL REVIEW FLANDERS** always includes work of *a dvvt* in its biennial edition.

Ai WEIWEI includes *a dvvt* in his selection of 10 for the publication **10X10_3**, published by **PHAIDON PRESS. TASCHEN** includes work in the edition **ARCHITECTURE NOW VOLUME 7**.

In its **PHAIDON WORLD ATLAS** work has been introduced. **DIVISARI** follows as many other digital platforms the work closely.

Early 2012 *a dvvt* provides the January issue of **DOMUS** by request from JOSEPH GRIMA. Cover, editorial and projects together with objects from JIJ'S make this **DOMUS 954** with its pure naked white cover with varnished letters to become a collector's item. But also recently in DOMUS FEBRUARI 2013 **966**.

In the QUADERNS #263 2013 HOUSE AND CONTRADICTION work is selected.

Own writings.

Those publications are not only on the work of *architecten de vylder vinck taillieu*. More recently and more and more also small essays are delivered by *architecten de vylder vinck taillieu*. Writing started up on the occasion of **1 boek 1 2 3**. It continued in the monographs as **2G**, **De Aedibus international** and **A+U**. And it goes also along in separate and other occasion to which a *dvvt* was invited. The writing goes sometimes along with the ideas of the projects but more and more takes distance of only the projects towards reflection and considerations.

Published by SUN PUBLISHERS, in series ARCHITECTURAL POSITIONS / ARCHITECTURE AS A CRAFT "THE DRAWING IS EVERYWHERE" appeared.

More recently are the contribution to the new ACCATTONE with a small essay called **THE SAN GOTTARDO DOUBLE**.

Recently a contribution was delivered to the latest issue of **DWB** on 50 fictive buildings based on Fjodor Dostojevski's 'Het **ondergrondse**' with a drawing. As also a contribution for **Werk, Bauen + Wohnen** (CH) called '**OCCAZIONEN**'.

a dvvt is particularly proud to find that their practice and work can be found as a reference in many a discourse concerning architecture. Adam Caruso referred to the work in his FEELING OF THINGS.

TEACHING AND LECTURING

International perspective.

architecten de vylder vinck taillieu has been invited as visiting critics many times. The TU DELFT was the first to invite. The USI AMM ACCADEMIA MENDRISIO (CH) followed many times. EPFL (2012); TU DARMSTAD (2013); KTH Stockholm (2013) are the latest interventions. Upcoming are Lisbon FAUL (2014) and SANDBERG/RIETVELD Amsterdam (NL)

Today architecten de vylder vinck taillieu are invited guest professors a many schools worldwide.

At the **USI AAM ACCADEMIA MENDRISIO** (CH) a studio took place from FALL 2013 till SPRING 2016. Along with the regular studio came a DIPLOMA studio with the title LIVE MEET PLAY SUPER POWER MOVE LEARN.

At **EPFL ENAC SAR LAUSANNE** (CH) a studio was picked up from FALL 2014 and so far till SPRING 2018. A longer professorship is a head.

jan de vylder inge vinck io taillieu

The summer **PORTO ACADEMY 2014** (PT) was a pleasure to be. The summer school titled **NOT YET SUMMERSCHOOL** at the KADK Copenhagen (DK) 2015 another pleasure. In 2016 Summer school **WA.V.E UIAV VENICE** (IT) was held with the name **MARGHERA FRAGMENT VENICE** and resulted in a publication with that name and reflecting that studio.

Today an associate professorship at **ETH ZURICH D-ARCH** is picked up for the period FALL 2017 till SPRING 2013. This professorship combines regular studio work with research work. Included is the participation in the Professorial Commissions and Departmental Commissions in order to be part of the future perspectives of the architecture department at the ETH. Membership of the **IEA – INSTITUT FUR ENTWURF UND ARCHITEKTUR** – is part of this position.

Future summer schools are a head. New visiting professorships are to be scheduled.

KUL FACULTY of ARCHITECTURE

But maybe first: being part of the KUL FACULTY OF ARCHITECTURE formerly known as SINT-LUCAS SCHOOL OF ARCHITECTURE; not only in teaching just a studio but also in enhancing themes shared in between studios. And last but not least a special yearly returning vertical studio facing real political topics makes that teaching a pleasure.

Research

It is evident to understand that the way *architecten de vylder vinck taillieu* makes its practice that this practice may and can be understood as the research by excellent in the field of architecture. Not only by the way practice and projects are given perspective but also the way reflection by bookmaking and exhibiting is each time taken as chance of reflection more then a chance of just presenting. The many books and exhibitions do give illustration on this.

Next to that is every moment of teaching picked up a new way of experiencing that ambition to reflection.

At this point *architecten de vylder vinck taillieu* is preparing a long term research under the working title UNIVERSE CARROUSEL JOURNEY at ETH Z D-ARCH. This research finds start in its CARROUSEL show at the gta exhibition space of the ETH 2015. And continuous in the studio work as well in the research work itself. Reflecting on the own work of *a dvvt* by illustrating the ideas of *a dvvt* with work made by others is the key to that research. This will research in a new book series to be revealed at the end of the term at ETH Z D-ARCH and will held many separate books on many specific works of many unknown architects. In the CAROUSSEL show for the first time this was exercised.

Lectures

As an unlimited listing. Perhaps these quotes could dismiss *architecten de vylder vinck taillieu* from the task to determine precisely what it's about, or should be about.

It's clear; *architecten de vylder vinck taillieu* does not set out a fixed course for their project – read: their practice –. There are no premises in this discourse. Maybe then the following could be said.

Architecture appears to be a critical science first and foremost. Somewhere here is where the belief in architecture of *architecten de vylder vinck taillieu* could lie. As a critical science that's not only reliant on the set of instruments of the so-called architecture discourse.

Rather a critical science that is developed from within the practice. A project doesn't begin with its discourse, but begins with its design. And this design; thereof *architecten de vylder vinck taillieu* beliefs that the 'reading' – understand: figuratively; to see, to listen, to understand – of everything as found and as known could already be the design.

In other words: the context; that is what first of all creates what will become. Context understood as place as well as time, program, or history. Context precedes concept. Concept can only be a vehicle with which architecture can be found. Architecture is eventually allowed a place in its context. Architecture can only be where its context is; can only 'be true' in a 'context'.

architecten de vylder vinck taillieu is always ready to weigh their critical ability again and again. Where today sustainability is bound to be the future, only a critical view on sustainability will be able to turn an even more distant future into history. Architecture is critical. The art of being critical nourishes the simplest of human acts always in a better way. To make things better is the progress architecture has to be.

Simple ideas, principles and belief: imagination and fantasy, critical and courage; but at the same time with a humble outcome. And of course: from their on the discourse will be found.
